Purpose

The focus of the Integrated Risk & Compliance Management (IRCM) course is to facilitate your learning with regard to integrating risk & compliance management systems across an organisation. IRCM is designed to build on your basic risk process knowledge and to assist you in establishing a framework for managing risk using Standard ISO31000: 2009 Risk Management – Principles and Guidelines. **It is not intended to focus on applying each of the basic steps of the Risk Standard in detail.**

Course Outline

The overall aim of Integrated Risk & Compliance Management is to enable participants to be able to use an integrated approach to managing their risk & compliance systems so as to be better able to make effective decisions and implement effective strategic organisational objectives.

Learning Outcomes

The course is based on the requirements of Standard ISO31000: 2009 Risk Management – Principles and Guidelines and the management of such a system.

Upon successful completion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Establish the risk management & compliance context that they operate in.
- Develop risk management & compliance policy.
- Establish infrastructure and processes for implementing risk & compliance management strategies.
- Maintain infrastructure and processes for managing risk & compliance management systems.
- Prepare to implement risk management & compliance strategy.
- Support other staff to manage risk & compliance.
- Facilitate risk recovery process.
- Monitor and review system implementation.
- Understand the links between governance, risk & compliance.

Benefits

At the completion of this course, participants will have:

- The capability to understand an integrated approach to strategic risk management.
- An ability to determine priorities for controlling risks in context of the whole organisation.
- The capability to establish agreed common risk terminology so that all stakeholders describe strategic and operational risks.
- An understanding of how to develop, implement, monitor, manage, report on and improve an integrated organisational-wide risk framework.
